And this doesn't change as people get older. At Minuteman Senior Services, we make that goal a reality for thousands of people each year. In fact, 3,357 people called our **Information Center** looking for assistance this past year alone.

For almost 50 years, Minuteman has been providing services that enable people to stay in their own homes. With your help, we have been able to meet the changing needs of older adults in Massachusetts.

Today, residents face increasing economic pressures, with inflation and the loss of enhanced pandemic supports. Far too many of our neighbors struggle with loneliness, hunger, and isolation. This year, our staff and volunteers delivered over 210,000 hot meals to homebound older adults—an increase of 20% over last year.

Private donations provide emergency funds to older people for fuel, food and medications.
