You might assist us in meeting our mission in another vital program, like *Money Management*, where seniors are supported with bill-paying and budgeting tasks, or as a *SHINE* volunteer, counseling Medicare recipients (or new retirees) about health insurance choices.

Many of you may be caring for a loved one with our supports. We value your contributions as a caregiver and appreciate your confidence in us.

Maybe you are a long-time donor who already knows how your donation in any amount directly supports people living in the setting of their choice (usually home) rather than in costly nursing home care. Or perhaps you are considering making a donation this year for the first time.

- Launch new programming that is responsive to our community's changing needs. By providing targeted nutrition counseling for people with dementia, we are **reducing re-hospitalizations and emergency room visits**. Our new Change of Condition phone application for *Meals on Wheels* enhances our role of being the **"eyes and ears in the home" of homebound seniors.**
