1. Senior Minivan/COA - Wheelchair Accessible

- Age 60+
- Medical, Shopping, Senior Center activities, Nutrition – Call for schedule
- Market Basket – Tuesday & Saturday 9am, Shaw's – every other Tuesday 9-9:30am

2. (Volunteer) FISH - Not Wheelchair Accessible

- Burlington residents only
- No age restriction
- Medical & Human Services Appointments
- Monday-Friday 9:00am-5:00pm
- **Destinations:** Burlington, Billerica, & surrounding towns if volunteer is willing

3. B Line Bus - Wheelchair Accessible

- 12 routes within Burlington. Runs on a set schedule
- Monday – Friday (7:30am-6:00pm)

4. THE RIDE (MBTA) - Wheelchair Accessible

- Disabled
- THE RIDE operates 365 days a year, generally from 5am -1am
- **Destinations:** Arlington, Bedford, Belmont, Billerica, Boston, Brookline, Burlington, Cambridge, Concord, Lexington, Lincoln, Medford, Newton, Somerville, Waltham, Watertown, Weston, Wilmington, Winchester, and Woburn
