

## TRANSPORTATION GUIDE

### TOWN of LINCOLN (Member of Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority (MBTA))

\*Please check with individual vendors for the most up to date information on schedules and COVID-19 requirements.

1. **COA – Cab (Lincoln Cab) - Not Wheelchair Accessible**
  - Age 60+ (Only for those not on The RIDE and without other resources)
  - Medical Appointments in Boston
  - Monday-Friday 9:00am - 4:00pm
  - **Destinations:** Boston
  - **Contact Info:** Call 781-259-8811 (Lincoln-Concord Coach, which does booking for both taxis and volunteer rides) with 3 business days' notice
  
2. **LINC Volunteer - Not Wheelchair Accessible**
  - Age 60+ (Only for those not on the RIDE and without other resources)
  - Medical & other health related appointments, local shopping, COA programs at Bemis Hall, and others as capacity allows
  - Monday-Friday 9:00am-4:00pm
  - **Destinations:** Lincoln and some immediate towns
  - **Contact Info:** Call (781) 259-8722 (Lincoln-Concord Coach, which does booking for both taxis and volunteer rides) with 3 business days' notice
  
3. **THE RIDE (MBTA) - Wheelchair Accessible**
  - Disabled
  - THE RIDE operates 365 days a year, generally from 5am -1am
  - **Destinations:** Arlington, Bedford, Belmont, Billerica, Boston, Brookline, Burlington, Cambridge, Concord, Lexington, Lincoln, Medford, Newton, Somerville, Waltham, Watertown, Weston, Wilmington, Winchester, and Woburn
