Following a comprehensive in-home assessment by a Minuteman Care Manager, a personalized care plan will be developed based on your needs, preferences, and available resources.

The care plan may include one or more of the following services:

- Adult Day Health
- Medication Dispensing System
- Chore Service
- Personal Care
- Companion
- Personal Emergency Response System
- Meals on Wheels
- Transportation
- Homemaking
- Adaptive Equipment
- Laundry Services
- Meal Preparation
- Grocery Shopping
- Care Management

The Minuteman Care Manager will discuss payment options with you. Depending on your income and level of need, some or all of your services may be available to you at no cost, on a sliding fee scale or on a private pay basis.

The Consumer Directed Care program is an option that allows some people who are eligible for state home care to hire their own paid caregiver. This worker can be a family member (not spouse) friend or neighbor who will receive payment through a fiscal intermediary for these services.
